

Organization Updates

While the COVID-19 pandemic continued in 2021, Portico kept its commitment to helping Minnesotans access health coverage and care. Portico continued with a remote service model while making changes to staffing and technology to become more efficient and to better serve client needs. Portico also established a revenue-generating contract model with local health related organizations.





Health disparities due to race continue to impact Minnesotans of Color. To reflect Portico's ongoing commitment to increase access to health coverage and care for all Minnesotans, Portico changed our mission statement to reflect our work to increase health equity.

Client Story

Julie was experiencing a serious medical condition that caused her to faint unexpectedly. Her condition left her unable to work and her son was caring for her at home. After an initial consultation at a community clinic, she was referred to a neurologist. However, as Julie no longer had employer-sponsored insurance, she did not have the health insurance needed to access specialist care.

The community clinic referred Julie to Portico and a Portico navigator helped her complete an application for Medical Assistance. Julie was approved the same day. Knowing Julie's situation was urgent, the navigator helped Julie call her county to obtain her medical ID number right away. With active insurance, Julie was able to schedule her neurologist appointment and get the health care she needs.


